It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 27-10.1 of the General Laws entitled "Motor Vehicle Damage
2	Appraisers" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
3	27-10.1-11. Emergency licenses (a) Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this
4	chapter, the commissioner may grant emergency licenses to permit an experienced motor vehicle
5	appraiser to act as a motor vehicle physical damage appraiser in this state without a Rhode Island
6	license if:
7	(1) The appraiser is either a licensed appraiser in another state which requires a license or
8	regularly appraises motor vehicle damage in another state where such licensing is not required
9	and works for an insurance company authorized to do business in Rhode Island;
10	(2) He or she is engaged in emergency insurance appraisal work during the period of
11	emergency only, as determined by the commissioner.
12	(b) The experienced appraiser may work in this state either for an employer who is an
13	appraiser licensed by this state, or for a regular employer of one or more appraisers licensed by
14	this state, or for an insurance company authorized to do business in this state; provided, that the
15	employer or insurer shall furnish to the commissioner a notice in writing or electronically
16	promptly after the beginning of any emergency insurance appraisal work. The appraiser may
17	appraise claims within or outside the state.
18	Emergency licenses permitted under this section shall not exceed one hundred twenty

- 1 (c) As used in this section, "emergency insurance appraisal work" means and includes,
- 2 but is not limited to, appraisal of motor vehicle damage during the term of an emergency license
- 3 following an event or catastrophe as determined by the commissioner, or a state of disaster
- 4 declared by the governor of the state of Rhode Island or by the president of the United States
- 5 <u>under applicable federal law.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE -- MOTOR VEHICLE DAMAGE APPRAISERS

This act would permit the insurance commissioner to grant emergency licenses to permit
certain experienced motor vehicle appraisers to act as motor vehicle physical damage appraisers
during periods of emergency.

This act would take effect upon passage.
