It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 9-26-4.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 9-26 entitled "Levy and
 Sale on Execution" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 9-26-4.1. Homestead estate exemption. -- (a) In addition to the property exempt from attachment as set forth in section 9-26-4, an estate of homestead to the extent of three hundred 4 5 thousand dollars (\$300,000) in the land and buildings may be acquired pursuant to this section by an owner or owners of a home, including manufactured homes or one or all who rightfully 6 7 possess the premise by lease or otherwise, and who occupy or intend to occupy the home as a 8 principal residence. The estate of homestead provided pursuant to this section shall be automatic 9 by operation of law, and without any requirement or necessity for the filing of a declaration, a 10 statement in a deed, or any other documentation. The estate shall be exempt from the laws of 11 attachment, levy on execution and sale for payment of debts or legacies except in the following 12 cases:

13 (1) Sale for taxes, sewer liens, water liens, lighting district assessments and fire district
14 assessments;

15 (2) For a debt contracted prior to the acquisition of the estate of homestead;

16 (3) For a debt contracted for the purchase of the home;

17 (4) Upon an order issued by the family court to enforce its judgment that a spouse pay a

18 certain amount weekly or otherwise for the support of a spouse or minor children;

(5) Where a building or buildings are situated on land not owned by the owner of a
 homestead estate are attached, levied upon or sold for the ground rent of the lot upon which the
 building or buildings are situated;

4 (6) for a debt due to, or a lien in favor of, the department of human services and/or the
5 state of Rhode Island for reimbursement of medical assistance, as provided for in section 40-8-15;
6 (7) For a debt heretofore or hereafter owing to a federally insured deposit taking

7 institution or a person regulated or licensed under title 19.

8 (b) For the purposes of this section, "owner of a home" includes a sole owner, joint 9 tenant, tenant by the entirety or tenant in common; provided, that only one owner may acquire an 10 estate of homestead in the home for the benefit of his or her family; and provided further, that an 11 estate of homestead may be acquired on only one principal residence for the benefit of a family. 12 For the purposes of this section, "family" includes either a parent and child or children, a husband 13 and wife and their children, if any, or a sole owner. The provisions of this section shall not apply 14 to any debt owing to a financial institution, or private mortgages, or a mechanics' lien on the property comprising the estate as provided for under chapter 28 of title 34. Notwithstanding any 15 16 other provisions of law, it shall not be necessary to record a declaration of homestead in order to 17 take advantage of the homestead estate exemption.

(c) As used in this section, "manufactured home" means any structure, transportable in
one or more sections, which, in the traveling mode, is eight (8) body feet or more in width and
forty (40) body feet or more in length, or when erected on site, is three hundred twenty (320)
square feet or more, and which is built on a permanent chassis and designed to be used as a
dwelling with or without a permanent foundation when connected to required utilities, which
include plumbing, heating and electrical heating systems contained therein.
SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
