It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 31-25 of the General Laws entitled "Size, Weight, and Load
   Limits" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>31-25-27.7. Weight restrictions on route 114--Warren. (a) No commercial motor</u>
- 4 truck or tractor with a gross weight exceeding four (4) tons, except those listed in this section,
- 5 <u>shall be allowed to travel on route 114 in the town of Warren.</u>
- 6 (b) The director of the department of transportation is directed to post signs to limit
  7 access as prescribed in subsection (a) of this section.
- 8 (c) The following vehicles shall be exempt from the provisions of this section: any 9 commercial vehicle whose destination is anywhere, either on or off the routes stated in subsection 10 (a) of this section; any and all emergency vehicles, state vehicles, municipal vehicles, public 11 transit vehicles, marked school administration vehicles, and vehicles participating in the annual 12 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade or other civic parades. 13 (d) Any commercial registered motor truck or tractor with a gross weight exceeding four 14 (4) tons, shall be prohibited from traveling the routes stated in subsection (a), provided, however, commercial registered motor trucks, tractors, and equipment exceeding four (4) tons, including 15
- 16 <u>tractor trailer trucks, shall be allowed to travel north of Child Street (Route 103) on Main Street to</u>
- 17 get to and from Barrington. Signs will be posted by the department of transportation stating
- 18 <u>"Local Deliveries Only No Through Trucking 4 Ton Weight Limit."</u>
- 19 (e) Violations of this section shall be a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first offense,

- 1 not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) for each and every subsequent offense.
  - SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
