It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11-52-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-52 entitled "Computer Crime" is hereby amended to read as follows:

11-52-7. Use of false information. -- (a) Whoever intentionally or knowingly makes a

transmission of false data for the purpose of submitting a claim for payment, or makes, presents,

or uses or causes to be made, presented, or used any data for the purpose of submitting a claim for

payment, shall be guilty of a felony and shall be subject to the penalties set forth in section 11-52-

9 (b) Whoever intentionally or knowingly: (1) makes a transmission of false data; or (2)

10 makes, presents or uses or causes to be made, presented or used any data for any other purpose

11 with knowledge of its falsity, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to the
