It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 31-10-6.3 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-10 entitled
2 "Operators' and Chauffeurs' Licenses" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **31-10-6.3. Duration and fee. --** A limited instruction permit ~~expires on~~ shall not expire
4 until sixty (60) days after the eighteenth (18th) birthday of the permit holder, during which period
5 the provisional license restrictions shall not apply. A limited provisional license expires on the
6 eighteenth (18th) birthday of the permit holder. A full operator's license shall be issued and
7 expires on the date pursuant to section 31-10-30. The fee for a limited instruction permit or a
8 limited provisional license is ten dollars (\$10.00). The fee for a full operator's license is the
9 amount prescribed in section 31-10-31.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
