It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6-13-17 of the General Laws in Chapter 6-13 entitled "Unfair Sales

2 Practices" is hereby amended to read as follows:

6-13-17. Requiring consumers to furnish social security numbers. -- (a) Unless 4 otherwise required by federal law, no person shall require that a consumer of goods or services 5 disclose all or part of a social security number incident to the sale of consumer goods or services;

- provided, however, that: 6
- 7 (1) Insurance companies and institutions licensed by the state or federal government for 8 financial services may require applicants for those services to disclose their social security 9 number;

10 (2) Social security numbers may be required for the providing and billing of health care 11 or pharmaceutical-related services, including the issuance of identification cards and account 12 numbers for users of health care or pharmaceutical-related services; and

- 13 (3) Disclosure may be required of a consumer as a condition of applying for a credit card or the extension of credit for the purchase or rental of goods or services. 14
- 15 (b) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, 16 and upon conviction, shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500).

17 (c) In any civil action alleging a violation of this section, the court may award damages, 18 reasonable attorney's fees, and costs to a prevailing consumer, and afford injunctive relief against

- 1 any person or business that commits or proposes to commit a violation of this section.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
