It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

3	42-26-6. Criminal justice policy board Appointment of members The criminal
4	justice policy board shall consist of:
5	(1) The attorney general;
6	(2) The superintendent of the state police and director of the department of public safety;
7	(3) The public defender;
8	(4) The director of the department of corrections;
9	(5) The director of the department of human services;
10	(6) The director of the department of mental health, retardation, and hospitals;
11	(7) The chairperson of the state board of governors for higher education;
12	(8) The director of the department of children, youth, and families;
13	(9) The chief justice of the family court;
14	(10) The president of the Rhode Island Police Chiefs Association;
15	(11) One police chief selected by the Rhode Island Police Chiefs Association;
16	(12) The chief justice of the Rhode Island Supreme Court;
17	(13) The presiding justice of the superior court;

1	(15) Seven (7) members of the general assembly; four (4) from the house of
2	representatives, at least one of whom shall be a member of the minority, to be appointed by the
3	speaker, and three (3) from the senate, at least one of whom shall be a member of the minority, to
4	be appointed by the president of the senate;
5	(16)(15) The executive director of the Rhode Island League of Cities and Towns;
6	(17)(16) The director of health;
7	(18)(17) The director of the division of fire safety;
8	(19)(18) One university or college faculty member with a research background in
9	criminal justice appointed by the governor;
10	(20)(19) Four (4) citizens appointed by the governor;
11	(21)(20) Three (3) representatives appointed by the governor from community service
12	organizations.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
