RELATING TO TAXATION - OUTPATIENT FACILITY AND IMAGING SERVICES SURCHARGE

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 44-64-2 of the General Laws in Chapter 44-64 entitled "The
- 2 Outpatient Health Care Facility Surcharge" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>44-64-2. Definitions. --</u> The following words and phrases as used in this chapter have the
- 4 following meaning:
- 5 (1) "Administrator" means the tax administrator within the department of revenue.
- 6 (2) "Gross patient revenue" means the gross amount received on a cash basis by the
- 7 provider from all patient care and other gross operating income. However, charitable
- 8 contributions, fund raising proceeds, and endowment support shall not be considered "gross
- 9 patient revenue."
- 10 (3) "Net patient services revenue" means the charges related to patient care services less
- 11 (i) charges attributable to charity care, (ii) bad debt expenses, and (iii) contractual allowances,
- and (iv) charges attributable to medical supplies used within the outpatient health care facility.
- 13 (4) "Person" means any individual, corporation, company, association, partnership, joint
- stock association, and the legal successor thereof.
- 15 (5) "Provider" means a licensed facility or operator, including a government facility or
- operator, subject to a surcharge under this chapter.
- 17 (6) "Surcharge" means the assessment that is imposed upon net patient revenue pursuant
- 18 to this chapter.

1	SECTION 2. Section 44-65-2 of the General Laws in Chapter 44-65 entitled "Imaging
2	Services Surcharge" is hereby amended to read as follows:
3	44-65-2. Definitions The following words and phrases as used in this chapter have the
4	following meaning:
5	(1) "Administrator" means the tax administrator within the department of administration.
6	(2) "Gross patient revenue" means the gross amount received on a cash basis by a
7	provider from all income derived from the provision of imaging services to patients. Charitable
8	contributions, fundraising proceeds, and endowment support shall not be considered as "gross
9	patient revenue."
10	(3) "Imaging services" means and includes all the professional and technical components
11	of x-ray, ultrasound (including echocardiography), computed tomography (CT), magnetic
12	resonance imaging (MRI), positron emission tomography (PET), positron emission
13	tomography/computed tomography (PET/CT), general nuclear medicine, and bone densitometry
14	procedures.
15	(4) "Net patient services revenue" means the charges related to patient care services less
16	(i) charges attributable to charity care, (ii) bad debt expenses, and (iii) contractual allowances,
17	and (iv) charges attributable to medical supplies used for imaging services.
18	(5) "Person" means any individual, corporation, company, association, partnership, joint
19	stock association, and the legal successor thereof.
20	(6) "Provider" means any person who furnishes imaging services for the purposes of
21	patient diagnosis, assessment or treatment, excluding any person licensed as a hospital or a
22	rehabilitation hospital center or a not-for-profit organization ambulatory care facility, pursuant to
23	the provisions of chapter 17 of title 23 of the Rhode Island general laws, as amended or not
24	performing more than two hundred (200) radiological procedures per month. Further, the term
25	"provider" shall not apply to any person subject to the provisions of chapter 64 of title 44 or to
26	any person licensed in the state of Rhode Island as a dentist or a podiatrist or a veterinarian.
27	(7) "Surcharge" means the assessment imposed upon net patient revenue pursuant to this
28	chapter.
29	SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
