## HOUSE RESOLUTION

## PROCLAIMING APRIL 12TH TO BE "LEAGUE DAY AT THE STATE HOUSE 2012"

1 WHEREAS, The League of Women Voters is a nonpartisan political organization that 2 encourages the informed and active participation of citizens in government, works to increase 3 understanding of major public policy issues, and influences public policy through education and 4 advocacy; and 5 WHEREAS, The League of Women Voters of the United States, founded by suffragists in 1920, celebrated its 92<sup>nd</sup> anniversary on February 14, 2012, and continues to study and 6 7 advocate nationally for issues such as fair elections, open government, campaign finance reform, 8 women's rights, and clean air and environmental issues. Currently, the League is in the process of 9 a national study on privatization of public services; and 10 WHEREAS, The League of Women Voters of Rhode Island also celebrated its 92<sup>nd</sup> 11 anniversary in 2012; has recently completed a two-year statewide study of and reached consensus 12 on basic principles for education financing in Rhode Island; followed the state redistricting 13 process; and is lobbying this legislative session on redistricting, open records, open meetings, 14 ethics, election issues, campaign finance reporting and a woman's right to choice -- positions all 15 based on studies and adopted at the state and national levels. Live broadcasts this fall of nonpartisan Congressional candidate forums on ABC6-TV and RI Public Radio are being organized 16 17 and planned by the Voter Services Committee of the League; and 18 WHEREAS, Local Leagues of Women Voters in Providence, West Bay, Newport 19 County, and South Kingstown/ Narragansett will be registering voters, organizing local non-

partisan forums for many Rhode Island legislative, town/city council, and school committee

1 candidates, and holding meetings discussing issues of interest to members and citizens regarding

the government's role in education, charter schools, pension reform, and privatization of other

3 public services; now, therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island and

Providence Plantations hereby acknowledges and declares April 12, 2012, to be "League Day at

6 the State House 2012"; and be it further
