It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 9-26-5 of the General Laws in Chapter 9-26 entitled "Levy and Sale

2 on Execution" is hereby amended to read as follows:

9-26-5. Exemption of police and firefighters' pensions -- Assignments invalid. -- No

interest of any person in any pension fund or in any pension derivable therefrom, for the benefit

of police officers or firefighters, now or hereafter created or held by authority of law by any city

or town, or by any public officer or officers or board of officers therein, to which fund the city or

7 town contributes in any way, shall be subject to trustee process or liable to attachment on any

8 writ, original, mesne, or judicial, or be taken on execution or any process, legal or equitable; and

no assignment of any such interest shall be valid, except where such person's liability results

from entry of a civil judgment based on a conviction for murder as defined in Rhode Island

11 general laws, section 11-23-1 or 11-23-2.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
