It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 7-13-48 of the General Laws in Chapter 7-13 entitled "Limited
- 2 Partnerships" is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - **7-13-48. Applicable law. --** Subject to the constitution of this state:
- 4 (1) The laws of the state under which a foreign limited partnership is organized govern 5 its organization and internal affairs and the liability of its limited partners, and except as to
- 6 foreign limited liability limited partnerships, which shall be treated as if they were foreign limited
- 7 <u>partnerships;</u>

- 8 (2) A foreign limited partnership may not be denied registration by reason of any
  9 difference between those laws and the laws of this state<del>,</del>; and
- 10 (3) A certificate of registration does not authorize a foreign limited partnership to engage
- 11 in any business or exercise any power that a limited partnership may not engage in or exercise in
- 12 this state.
- 13 SECTION 2. Chapter 7-13 of the General Laws entitled "Limited Partnerships" is hereby
- 14 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 15 <u>7-13-52.1. Foreign Application for Transfer of Authority. (a) A duly authorized</u>
- 16 foreign limited partnership in the state of Rhode Island that converts into any form of foreign or
- 17 other entity subject to the provisions of Title 7 and the resulting entity is required to file for
- 18 <u>authority to transact business in this state may apply for a transfer of authority in the office of the</u>

- 1 <u>secretary of state by filing:</u>
- 2 (1) An Application for Transfer of Authority that has been executed and filed in
- 3 accordance with section 7-13-11;
- 4 (2) An application for authority to transact business in the state of Rhode Island for the
- 5 <u>resulting entity type; and</u>
- 6 (3) A certificate of legal existence or good standing issued by the proper officer of the
- 7 state or country under the laws of which the resulting entity has been formed.
- 8 (b) The Application for Transfer of Authority shall state:
- 9 (1) The name of the limited partnership;
- 10 (2) The type of other entity into which it has been converted; and
- 11 (3) The jurisdiction whose laws govern its internal affairs.
- 12 (c) Upon the effective time and date of the Application for Transfer of Authority, the
- 13 authority of the limited partnership authorized to transact business under this chapter shall be
- 14 transferred without interruption to the other entity which shall thereafter hold such authority
- 15 subject to the provisions of the laws of the state of Rhode Island applicable to that type of
- 16 <u>resulting entity.</u>
- 17 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
