It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 31-10-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-10 entitled "Operators'
and Chauffeurs' Licenses" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 31-10-7. Temporary driver's permit -- Persons over the age of eighteen (18). -- The division of motor vehicles may in its discretion issue a temporary driver's permit to an applicant 4 5 for a full operator's license who has attained the age of eighteen (18). A temporary driver's permit 6 shall permit the applicant to operate a motor vehicle while the division of motor vehicles is 7 completing its investigation and determination of all facts relative to the applicant's right to 8 receive a full operator's license. The temporary driver's permit must be in the applicant's 9 immediate possession while operating a motor vehicle, and it shall be invalid when the applicant's 10 license has been issued or for good cause has been refused. A supervising driver, as defined in 11 section 31-10-6.1, must be seated beside the permit holder in the front seat of the vehicle when it
