It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 37-2-62 of the General Laws in Chapter 37-2 entitled "State
 Purchases" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>37-2-62. Evaluation of qualifications and performance data. --</u> (a) The committee
 4 shall evaluate:
- 5 (1) Statements that may be submitted in response to the solicitation of architectural,
- 6 engineering, or consultant services; and
- 7 (2) Statements of qualifications and performance data, if their submission was required.
- 8 (b) All statements and statements of qualifications and performance data shall be 9 evaluated in light of the criteria set forth in the solicitation for architectural, engineering, or 10 consultant services.
- 11 (c) The committee may utilize the services of such persons it deems necessary to provide
- 12 advice in evaluating consultant proposals. Such advisors, whether state employees or private
- 13 consultants, shall not be considered members of the committee and shall not be entitled to vote.
- 14 (d) Except for owner's program managers procured pursuant to this chapter, such advisors
- 15 <u>shall not be entitled to compensation for their services.</u>
- 16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
