RELATING TO THE PRESERVATION OF FARM LAND AND OPEN SPACE IN THE
TOWN OF GLOCESTER AND ESTABLISHING A LAND TRUST

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 548 of the 1987 Public Laws entitled “An Act Relating
2 to the Preservation of Farm Land and Open Space in the Town of Glocester and Establishing a
3 Land Trust”, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 SECTION 2. The trust shall be administered by seven (7) trustees, ~~five (5) of~~ whom shall
5 be appointed by the town council. ~~The trustees who are first appointed shall be designated to~~
6 ~~serve for terms of one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4) and five (5) years respectively. Thereafter,~~
7 ~~trustees shall be appointed as aforesaid for a term of office of five (5) years, except that all~~
8 ~~vacancies occurring during a term shall be filled for the unexpired term. In addition to the five (5)~~
9 ~~trustees appointed by the town council, the current chairperson or member designee of the~~
10 ~~Glocester Conservation Commission and Glocester Planning Board shall also be trustees. One (1)~~
11 ~~trustee shall be a member of the Glocester Planning Board and one (1) trustee shall be a member~~
12 ~~of the Glocester Conservation Commission, each of whom shall serve a term of one (1) year. The~~
13 ~~other trustees who are first appointed shall be designated to serve for terms of one (1), two (2),~~
14 ~~three (3), four (4) and five (5) years respectively. Thereafter, trustees other than those trustees~~
15 ~~who are appointed for a one (1) year term as set forth above shall be appointed as aforesaid for a~~
16 ~~term of office of five (5) years, except that all vacancies occurring during a term shall be filled for~~
17 ~~the unexpired term.~~ Trustees shall be electors of the town of Glocester, shall serve without
18 compensation and shall hold office until their successors have been named. No trustee may be an

1 elected officer of the town. [Trustees may be removed by the town council in accordance with](#)
2 [applicable town procedures.](#)

3 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
