WHEREAS, Earning an Eagle Scout Badge is the pinnacle of achievement within the
 Boy Scouts of America. It is an exceptional distinction achieved by fewer than five percent of all
 the young men who enter scouting; and
 WHEREAS, Andrew Wynsen is a remarkable young man worthy of this prestigious

5 achievement and his accomplishments are truly deserving of our recognition; and

6 WHEREAS, Learning important lifelong skills and values, Andrew Wynsen of Troop 7 152, North Kingstown, Rhode Island, earned the required number of merit badges and has 8 demonstrated his leadership in a variety of positions, including Troop Guide, Patrol Leader, 9 Instructor, and Senior Patrol Leader; and

WHEREAS, As the highlight of his scouting years and to complete the final step toward obtaining the rank of Eagle, Andrew carried out an extensive Eagle Scout service project, which consisted of taking on the challenge of organizing the collection of used eyeglasses to be sent to developing countries. Andrew, with help from the Lions Club's "Recycle for Sight" program, was able to collect more than 400 pairs of glasses for people in need. Andrew devoted countless hours and an amazing amount of energy carrying out his project; and

WHEREAS, In addition to completing the necessary requirements for his Eagle Badge,
Andrew has participated in numerous outdoor adventures, including several cycling trips on
Block Island, as well as camping trips to New Hampshire, Camp Hoffman, Buck Hill, and
Yawgoog Boy Scout Camp; and

An 2 aspiring musician, Andrew plays jazz piano in his high school band and also plays in a small jazz 3 combo, performing for events and special occasions. He has earned a spot as the pianist in the 4 Rhode Island All-State Senior Jazz Band, which will be performing this summer at the Newport 5 Jazz Festival. After graduation, he plans on attending the University of Connecticut to pursue a 6 double major in Physiology and Jazz Studies; and

WHEREAS, It is essential and fitting to recognize the triumphs of our youth and to
celebrate the accomplishments of our future leaders. Eagle Scout Andrew Wynsen exemplifies
everything an Eagle Scout should be and all that we hope our children will grow to be; now,
