RECOGNIZING MAY 6TH-12TH AS "NATIONAL NURSES WEEK"

1 WHEREAS, The nearly 3.1 million registered nurses in the United States comprise our 2 nation's largest health care profession; and 3 WHEREAS, The depth and breadth of the registered nursing profession meet the different and emerging health care needs of the American population in a wide range of settings; 4 5 and 6 WHEREAS, The American Nurses Association, as the voice for the registered nurses of 7 this country, is working to chart a new course for a healthy nation that relies on increasing 8 delivery of primary and preventive health care; and 9 WHEREAS, A renewed emphasis on primary and preventive health care will require the 10 better utilization of all of our nation's registered nursing resources; and 11 WHEREAS, Professional nursing has been demonstrated to be an indispensable 12 component in the safety and quality of care of hospitalized patients; and 13 WHEREAS, The demand for registered nursing services will be greater than ever 14 because of the aging of the American population, the continuing expansion of life-sustaining 15 technology, and the explosive growth of home health care services; and WHEREAS, More qualified registered nurses will be needed in the future to meet the 16 17 increasingly complex needs of health care consumers in this community; and 18 WHEREAS, The cost-effective, safe, and quality health care services provided by 19 registered nurses will be an ever more important component of the U.S. health care delivery system in the future; now, therefore be it 20

1 RESOLVED, That this Senate of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations 2 hereby joins the Rhode Island State Nurses Association and the American Nurses Association in 3 recognizing the week of May 6th through May 12th of 2012 as "National Nurses Week" in 4 celebration of the ways in which registered nurses strive to provide safe and high-quality patient 5 care and map out improvements to our health care system; and be it further

6 RESOLVED, That this Senate hereby urges the residents of this state to join us in 7 honoring the registered nurses who care for all of us. We furthermore celebrate registered 8 nursing's accomplishments and efforts to improve our health care system and extend our 9 appreciation for the nation's registered nurses not just during this week, but also at every 10 opportunity throughout the year; and be it further
