It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31-3 of the General Laws entitled "Registration of Vehicles" is 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 <u>31-3-94. Emergency medical technician plates. – (a) The administrator of the division</u> 4 of motor vehicles is empowered and authorized to make available to all licensed emergency 5 medical technicians a special motor vehicle registration plate for any motor vehicle eligible for registration as an automobile or for a commercial vehicle having a gross weight of ten thousand 6 7 pounds (10,000 lbs) or less. 8 (b) The special plate shall be displayed upon the same registration number assigned to the 9 vehicle for which it was issued and shall be used in place of and in the same manner as the 10 registration plates issued to the vehicle. The original registration plates for the vehicle shall be 11 removed from the vehicle and the registration certificate for the plates shall be carried in the 12 vehicle, in accordance with section 31-3-9. The registration certificate shall be in effect for the 13 special plate. The administrator shall be authorized to retain newly issued plate numbers, at his or 14 her discretion, for the purpose of conducting auctions of the right to use and display those numbers under such terms and conditions as the administrator may permit. 15 (c) Emergency medical technician plates shall be subject to a minimum prepaid order of 16 17 at least nine hundred (900) sets of plates. Said plates shall not be issued unless the minimum

(d) The administrator of the division of motor vehicles shall develop application forms,

- 1 pre-payment procedures and any other procedures deemed necessary to carry out the purposes of
- 2 this section.
- 3 (e) The administrator of the division of motor vehicles shall issue the plate upon the
- 4 payment of a service charge of twenty dollars (\$20.00) and a transfer charge of five dollars
- 5 (\$5.00) for the plate. All revenues shall be deposited as general revenues.
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
