RELATING TO ELECTIONS -- MAIL BALLOTS

(Elections)

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Sections 17-20-21 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-20 entitled "Mail
2 Ballots" are hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **17-20-21. Certifying envelopes. --** The secretary of state shall cause to be prepared and
4 printed and shall furnish with each mail ballot an envelope for sealing up and certifying the ballot
5 when returned. The envelope shall be printed in substantially the following form:

6 "After marking ballot or ballots, fold and enclose in this envelope and seal it. Certify to
7 statement hereon. Enclose in envelope addressed to board of elections, which must receive the
8 envelope not later than ~~nine o'clock (9:00)~~ eight o'clock (8:00) p.m. the day of election."

15 witnesses who must sign their names and addresses.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION
BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
OF
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1 This act would require that envelopes containing mail ballots be marked with a statement
2 noting, in part, that the board of elections must receive the mail ballot envelope "not later than
3 eight o'clock (8:00) pm the day of the election." The present law is nine o'clock.

4 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
