Threats to commit serious bodily harm to persons on school property. --4 (a) Whoever knowingly and willfully delivers or conveys, directly or indirectly, a verbal or 5 written threat to take the life of, or to inflict bodily harm, and the threat would place the person who is the object of the threat in reasonable apprehension of death or bodily harm, and such threat 6 7 is: 8 (1) On the grounds or premises of any elementary, middle, or secondary school property; 9 (2) At any elementary, middle, or secondary school-sponsored event; or 10 (3) On a school bus to any person or persons, regardless of whether the person who is the 11 object of the threat actually receives the threat, shall be guilty of a felony and shall be imprisoned 12 for not more than five (5) years, or fined not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or both. 13 (b) For purposes of this section, an electronically transmitted communication producing a 14 visual or electronic message is "written" or in writing. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 15
