It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

2 Administration" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 39-3-45. Confidentiality of records. -- (a) Any records of the division or commission 4 pertaining to a customer of a public utility shall be confidential; provided, however, that customer 5 records determined to be relevant and admissible during a proceeding before the commission or division and which are disclosed during that proceeding shall be deemed public. 6 7 (b) The administrator of the division, or his/her designee, may disclose pertinent customer information to other state departments, public or private agencies, or medical personnel 8 9 when it is deemed appropriate by the administrator in order to safeguard the health and welfare of 10 the customer and/or the customer's family members.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
