It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 17-19-24.2 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-19 entitled "Conduct
2	of Election and Voting Equipment, and Supplies" is hereby amended to read as follows:
3	<u>17-19-24.2. Voter identification</u> (a) Beginning on January 1, 2012, any person
4	claiming to be a registered and eligible voter who desires to vote at a primary election, special
5	election or general election shall provide proof of identity. For purposes of this section, proof of
6	identity shall include:
7	(1) A The following valid and current document documents showing a photograph of the
8	person to whom the document was issued, including without limitation:
9	(i) Rhode Island driver's license;
10	(ii) Rhode Island voter identification card;
11	(iii) United States passport;
12	(iv) Identification card issued by a United States educational institution;
13	(v) United States military identification card;
14	(vi) Identification card issued by the United States or the State of Rhode Island;
15	(vii) Government issued medical card-;
16	(2) A The following valid and current document documents without a photograph of the
17	person to whom the document was issued, including without limitation:

1	(ii) Social security card;
2	(iii) Government issued medical card.
3	(b) From and after January 1, 2014, any person claiming to be a registered and eligible
4	voter who desires to vote at a primary election, special election or general election shall provide
5	proof of identity listed in subdivisions (a)(1).
6	(c) No later than January 1, 2012, (b) Rhode Island voter identification cards will be
7	issued upon request, and at no expense to the voters, at locations and in accordance with
8	procedures established by rules and regulations promulgated by the secretary of state. The
9	purpose of this section is to provide voter identification cards to those voters who do not possess
10	the identification listed in subdivision (a)(1).
11	(d)(c) If the person claiming to be a registered and eligible voter is unable to provide
12	proof of identity as required in subdivisions (1) and (2) above, the person claiming to be a
13	registered voter shall be allowed to vote a provisional ballot pursuant to section 17-19-24.2 upon
14	completing a provisional ballot voter's certificate and affirmation. The local board shall determine
15	the validity of the provisional ballot pursuant to section 17-19-24.3.
16	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
