RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING THOMAS M. SULLIVAN ON ACHIEVING SCOUTING'S MOST DISTINGUISHED HONOR, THE RANK OF EAGLE SCOUT

1 WHEREAS, Not every boy, nor even every Scout, qualifies for the high rank of Eagle. 2 Strenuous physical hurdles, high mental requirements, strong personal character, indomitable 3 spirit and a commitment to community service are a rare combination of qualities and 4 achievements to find in one person. Thomas M. Sullivan is just such an extraordinary young man and his accomplishments are truly worthy and deserving of our recognition and praise; and 5 6 WHEREAS, During his years in scouting, Thomas has held several leadership positions 7 including Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Instructor, and Assistant Patrol Leader. He has 8 demonstrated wide-ranging abilities, effective skills and the kind of self-confidence that makes 9 him a worthy leader; and 10 WHEREAS, Learning important lifelong skills and values, Thomas earned a myriad of 11 merit badges. In addition, he also earned the Order of the Arrow, which is Scouting's honor 12 society; and

WHEREAS, Thomas has completed the arduous and demanding requirements necessary to be awarded the rank of Eagle Scout. As the highlight of his scouting years and to complete the final step toward obtaining the rank of Eagle, Thomas planned, financed, and designed an extensive Eagle Scout service project. His Eagle Project was to construct team benches for the Cumberland High School and town recreational athletic teams at Tucker Field.  School Variety Show and St. John Vianney Catholic Youth Group and is a volunteer at Historic
 Metcalf-Franklin Farm. He is the Captain of the Cross Country & Indoor Track Northern
 Division Championship Teams; and

WHEREAS, It is essential and fitting to recognize the triumphs of our youth, and to
celebrate the accomplishments of our future leaders. Thomas M. Sullivan is a remarkable young
man who exemplifies everything an Eagle Scout should be, and all that we hope our children will
grow to be; now, therefore be it
