RELATING TO CRIMINAL PROCEDURE - CRIME INJURIES COMPENSATION

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 12-25-21.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 12-25 entitled
 "Criminal Injuries Compensation" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- <u>12-25-21.1. Emergency fund for victims. --</u> (a) The office may award emergency
 compensation under this chapter for the: (1) burial Burial expenses of a victim who dies as a
 direct result of a violent crime as defined in this chapter; (2) Cost of the crime scene clean up; and
 (3) Relocation expenses.
 (b) The award for emergency compensation shall be awarded at the sole discretion of the
- 8 program administrator. The administrator may promulgate rules and regulations to administer the
- 9 provisions of this section.
- 10 (c) An award for emergency compensation for burial expenses shall not exceed the sum
- 11 of eight thousand dollars (\$8,000).
- 12 (d) An award for emergency compensation for crime scene clean up shall not exceed two
- 13 thousand dollars (\$2,000).
- (e) An award for emergency compensation for relocation costs shall not exceed two
 thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500).
- 16 (d)(f) The award for emergency compensation for burial expenses, crime scene clean up,
- 17 and relocation costs shall be deducted from the final award. In the event the victim is not eligible
- 18 for an award, the victim shall repay the amount of the emergency award to the fund.
- 19 (e) The office may award emergency compensation for the cost of crime scene clean up.

- 1 The crime scene clean up shall be limited to the cost of cleaning the blood from the crime scene.
- 2 The total emergency compensation for crime scene clean up shall not exceed one hundred fifty
- 3 dollars (\$150) per hour and shall not exceed the total amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000).
- 4 (f)(g) Any payments made for the emergency compensation shall be deducted from the
- 5 final award. In no event shall the final award exceed the maximum award of twenty-five thousand
- 6 dollars (\$25,000).
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
