It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

	It is chaeted by the General Assembly as follows.
1	SECTION 1. Chapter 16-21 of the General Laws entitled "Health and Safety of Pupils" is
2	hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
3	<u>16-21-35. School resource officers</u> (a) Every public school in the state may have a
4	school resource officer assigned to it. The school resource officer shall be available and present
5	on the school's grounds at all times during the regular school day of the particular school. The
6	school resource officer shall be a member and employee of the police department which serves
7	the particular school.
8	(b) Funding for the school resource officers shall be through the funding for the police
9	department that serves the particular school. Funding for the resource officer shall be separate
10	from foundation level school support as provided for in chapter 16-7 ("Foundation Level School
11	Support"). Provided, the general assembly shall include a separate appropriation to municipalities
12	as a portion of aid to cities and towns to assist in the costs of school resource officers. In making
13	such appropriation, the general assembly may consider the amount and percentage of the state's
14	share of foundation level school support given to the particular community, but such
15	consideration shall be as a guide only, and the state shall not be obligated to provide any set
16	percentage of funding for school resource officers.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
