RELATING TO LABOR AND LABOR RELATIONS - PAYMENT OF WAGES

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 28-14-2.2 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-14 entitled "Payment
2 of Wages" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **28-14-2.2. Frequency of payment.** -- (a) Except as provided in sections 28-14-4 and 28-
4 14-5, every employee other than employees of the state and its political subdivisions and of
5 religious, literary, or charitable corporations shall be paid weekly all due wages from his or her
6 employer, except those employees whose compensation is fixed at a biweekly, semi-monthly,
7 monthly, or yearly rate.

8 (b) The director may, upon written petition showing good and sufficient reason, permit
9 the employer and its affiliates to pay wages less frequently than weekly provided: ~~(1) The~~
10 ~~employer and its affiliates have more than two thousand five hundred (2500) employees located~~
11 ~~in Rhode Island; (2) The employer's average payroll exceeds one hundred thirty five percent~~
12 ~~(135%) of the average compensation of all employees in the state as defined in subsection 42-~~
13 ~~64.11-2(c); (3) The employer makes payment of wages regularly on a predesignated date no less~~
14 ~~than twice per month; and (4) The~~ the employer provides proof of a surety bond or other
15 sufficient demonstration of security in the amount of the highest biweekly payroll exposure in the
16 preceding year for the employees subject to the petition.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
