It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 28-14-2.2 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-14 entitled "Payment of Wages" is hereby amended to read as follows:

**28-14-2.2. Frequency of payment. --** (a) Except as provided in sections 28-14-4 and 28-14-5, every employee other than employees of the state and its political subdivisions and of religious, literary, or charitable corporations shall be paid weekly all due wages from his or her employer, except those employees whose compensation is fixed at a biweekly, semi-monthly, monthly, or yearly rate, and except those employees paid in accordance with subsection (b).

(b) The director may, upon written petition showing good and sufficient reason, permit the The employer and its affiliates may to pay wages less frequently than weekly provided: (1) The employer and its affiliates have more than two thousand five hundred (2500) employees located in Rhode Island; (2) The employer's average payroll exceeds one hundred thirty-five percent (135%) of the average compensation of all employees in the state as defined in subsection 42-64.11-2(e); (3)(1) The employer makes payment of wages regularly on a predesignated date no less than twice per month, which pay days shall be two (2) weeks apart as near as is practicable; and (4)(2) The employer provides proof to the director of a surety bond or other sufficient demonstration of security in the amount of the highest biweekly payroll exposure in the preceding year for the employees subject to the petition paid in accordance with this subsection.

1	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
