It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-64 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Economic

2 Development Corporation" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>42-64-38. Rapid Rhody lending program. -- (a) There shall be within the Rhode Island</u>

4 commerce corporation a coordinated lending program to be known as the "Rapid Rhody lending

- 5 program," structured to meet the needs of small employers within the state of Rhode Island.
- 6 (b) The program shall be administered by the commerce corporation's board of directors,
- 7 integrated with the small business loan fund program within the corporation, and focused on
- 8 providing access to capital within ninety (90) days to employers with under one hundred (100)
- 9 employees. Other conditions may be established by the board, provided the program shall require
- 10 the small business loan recipient to:
- 11 (1) Have operations in Rhode Island;
- 12 (2) Have been registered to conduct business for not less than twelve (12) months;
- 13 (3) Be current with the payment of all state taxes; and
- 14 (4) Maintain its business and jobs within the state of Rhode Island for a period of at least
- 15 <u>two (2) years after receipt of any such loan.</u>
- 16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2014.
