With 7 perseverance and determination, he has attained the highest rank in scouting, the Eagle, by 8 meeting all the extensive requirements; and 9 WHEREAS, During his years in scouting, Michael has demonstrated a wide-range of abilities, making him a worthy leader. Michael also exhibited high self-confidence and effective 10 11 skills; and 12 WHEREAS, Learning important lifelong skills and values, Michael earned a myriad of 13 merit badges, and as the pinnacle of his scouting years, he completed the final step toward 14 obtaining the rank of Eagle by planning and carrying out an extensive Eagle service project. 15 Michael mapped out the walking trails at the Monastery in Cumberland using global positioning 16 information and installed a board to display the trail map; and 17 WHEREAS, Attaining the rank of Eagle requires considerable perseverance and is
