# RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING NICHOLAS JAMES LIOTTA ON ATTAINING THE RANK OF EAGLE SCOUT

WHEREAS, Not every boy, nor even every Scout, qualifies for the high rank of Eagle.
Strenuous physical hurdles, high mental requirements, strong personal character, indomitable
spirit, and a commitment to community service are a rare combination of qualities and
achievements to find in one person. Nicholas James Liotta is just such an extraordinary young
man and his accomplishments are truly worthy and deserving of our recognition and praise; and

6 WHEREAS, Nicholas, a member of Boy Scout Troop 1, Arnold Mills, Rhode Island, 7 quickly advanced through the ranks. Using his skills and abilities for the common good, Nicholas 8 earned thirty-five merit badges and has demonstrated his leadership in several positions, 9 including Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, and Troop Instructor. He was inducted 10 into the Order of the Arrow and received the World Conservation Award. Through perseverance 11 and determination, he has attained the highest rank in scouting, the Eagle, by meeting all the 12 extensive requirements; and

WHEREAS, As the highlight of his scouting years, Nicholas completed the final step toward obtaining the rank of Eagle Scout by planning and carrying out an extensive Eagle service project. Nicholas's Eagle Project was to take on the challenge of organizing and planning the construction of a deck overlooking a small pond on the grounds of the MacColl Field YMCA, located in Lincoln, Rhode Island. The project involved removing rotting top boards and a few rotting supports, replacing them with the new wood, and building a railing. To raise the funds for this project, Nicholas collected and recycled old cell phones. Nicholas and fellow scouts devoted countless hours and an amazing amount of energy carrying out his project for the enjoyment of
 the community; and

WHEREAS, Currently an honor roll student at Mount Saint Charles, Nicholas is Class Treasurer as well as Student Council Treasurer, a member of the National Honor Society, a recipient of the Brother Louis Laperle Chemistry Scholarship, and a finalist in the National Merit Scholarship. He actively participates in extra curricular activities, such as the Chess Team, Lacrosse Team, fishing, map study, and airplane research. He is a member of the senior all-state band for both 2012 and 2013, and earned multiple medals at the Science Olympiad; and

9 WHEREAS, After graduation from Mount Saint Charles this June, he plans to continue 10 his education studying either aeronautical or civil engineering. He plans a career with the 11 National Transportation Safety Board and may also pursue graduate school to earn a Master's 12 Degree; and

WHEREAS, Nicholas James Liotta upholds the dignity and virtue of a true Eagle, and
has proven himself to be worthy of trust and a truly dynamic leader; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations hereby honors Nicholas James Liotta on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout. Convinced that Nicholas's distinguished career in Scouting will prepare him for a life replete with accomplishments and success, we are certain that he will continue to dedicate a large part of that life to the service of others.
