It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 45-2 of the General Laws entitled "General Powers" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>45-2-62. Town of Coventry Regulation of asphalt or continuous mixing facilities. –</u>
- 4 (a) No asphalt batching or continuous mix facility shall be located in the town of Coventry in an
- 5 area which is less than four thousand feet (4,000') from any hospital, nursing home, school, area
- 6 of critical environmental concern, watercourse, or area occupied by residential housing. Such
- 7 distance shall be measured from the outermost perimeter of the facilities property line to the
- 8 <u>outermost point of such properties as mentioned herein.</u>
- 9 (b) Any facility in operation, prior to the enactment of this section, shall not be subject to
- 10 <u>the provisions of this section.</u>
- 11 (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), this section shall not apply to any
- 12 portable asphalt batching plant otherwise permitted under federal, state, or local ordinances, rules,
- 13 <u>or regulations.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO TOWNS AND CITIES - GENERAL POWERS

1 This act would regulate the location and use of, asphalt batching or continuous mixing 2 facilities in the town of Coventry. This act would exempt portable asphalt batching facilities in 3 compliance with federal, state, and local rules, ordinances, and regulations and further allow for 4 the continued operation of any facility in existence prior to the enactment of this act. 5 This act would take effect upon passage.
