It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5-45-8 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-45 entitled "Nursing

Home Administrators" is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-45-8. Licensure in other jurisdictions. -- The department may issue a nursing home

4 administrator's license without examination, to any person who holds a current license in good

5 standing as a nursing home administrator from another jurisdiction; provided, that the department

finds that the individual meets education and experience requirements as established by the

department regulation. For purposes of this section the department shall treat an applicant's

8 experience in a management position having direct responsibility for overseeing and directing a

number of licensed nursing home administrators as equivalent to experience as an administrator

of a licensed long-term care facility.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
