7	(2) Require that any tenant, prospective tenant, occupant, or prospective occupant of the

9	immigration or citizenship status.
10	(b) No municipality or housing agency shall compel a landlord or any agent of the
11	landlord to make any inquiry, compile, disclose, report, or provide any information, prohibit
12	offering or continuing to offer, accommodations in the property for rent or lease, or otherwise
13	take any action regarding or based on the immigration or citizenship status of a tenant.
