It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Sections 17-20-21 of the General Laws in Chapter 17-20 entitled "Mail

2 Ballots" are hereby amended to read as follows:

3 <u>17-20-21. Certifying envelopes. --</u> The secretary of state shall cause to be prepared and

printed and shall furnish with each mail ballot an envelope for sealing up and certifying the ballot
when returned. The envelope shall be printed in substantially the following form:

6 "After marking ballot or ballots, fold and enclose in this envelope and seal it. Certify to

7 statement hereon. Enclose in envelope addressed to board of elections, which must receive the

8 envelope not later than nine o'clock (9:00) eight o'clock (8:00) p.m. the day of election."

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

RELATING TO ELECTIONS -- MAIL BALLOTS

This act would require that envelopes containing mail ballots be marked with a statement
 noting, in part, that the board of elections must receive the mail ballot envelope "not later than
 eight o'clock (8:00) pm the day of the election." The present law is nine o'clock.
 This act would take effect upon passage.
