It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 11-19 of the General Laws entitled "Gambling and Lotteries" is 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 11-19-32.2. Senior citizens' center -- Bingo allowed. -- (a) Notwithstanding any other 4 provision of this chapter to the contrary, any organization which operates a public senior citizens 5 center or senior center may obtain a permit approved by the department to conduct bingo games in said senior citizens center or senior center for up to five (5) calendar days per week, excluding 6 7 Sundays. 8 (b) As used herein, the terms "senior citizens center" or "senior center" means an 9 organization whose goal is the promotion of various recreational and educational activities to 10 senior citizens and which receives a combination of federal, state, municipal and private funds to 11 provide such services at a community facility. 12 (c) A senior citizens center or senior center may conduct bingo games if it complies with 13 all of the following requirements: 14 (1) All bingo games are conducted only on the premises of the center's facility; 15 (2) All participants are age fifty-five (55) years of age or older; provided, this shall not prohibit a person who is less than fifty-five (55) years of age from assisting a senior citizen in 16 17 playing the game; 18 (3) All bingo game operators are sixty (60) years of age or older and receive no
