RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY - CODE CONSISTENCY COUNCIL

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

| 1 | SECTION 1. Title 23 of the General Laws entitled "HEALTH AND SAFETY" is hereby |
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| 2 | amended by adding thereto the following chapter: |
| 3 | CHAPTER 88 |
| 4 | CODE CONSISTENCY COUNCIL |
| 5 | 23-88-1. Purpose It is the purpose of this chapter to establish a council to examine |
| 6 | areas within the building code, fire code, elevator code, and any other codes that overlap, conflict |
| 7 | or may be inconsistent. The council shall examine these codes and make recommendations that |
| 8 | may resolve the conflict or inconsistency by selecting the "lead" code on a particular issue, by |
| 9 | making all the codes consistent or by allowing the inconsistencies as they serve a purpose and do |
| 10 | not directly conflict with each other. |
| 11 | 23-88-2. Establishment. – (a) There is hereby established a council to be called the |
| 12 | "Code Consistency Council" consisting of fifteen (15) members: |
| 13 | (1) One of whom shall be the state fire marshal and who shall serve as a co-chairperson; |
| 14 | (2) One of whom shall be the state building code commissioner who shall serve as a co- |
| 15 | chairperson; |
| 16 | (3) One of whom shall be the president of the American institute of architects Rhode |
| 17 | Island, or his or her designee; |
| 18 | (4) One of whom shall be the president of the structural engineers association of Rhode |
| 19 | Island, or his or her designee: |

| 1 | (3) One of whom shall be the president of the Khode Island association of the righters, of |
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| 2 | his or her designee; |
| 3 | (6) One of whom shall be the president of the Rhode Island chapter of the associated |
| 4 | general contractors, or his or her designee; |
| 5 | (7) One of whom shall be the president of the housing network or his or her designee; |
| 6 | (8) Two (2) of whom shall be appointed by the director of the department of labor and |
| 7 | training, one with an expertise in elevator safety rules and regulations and one with an expertise |
| 8 | in boiler safety rules and regulations; |
| 9 | (9) Two (2) of whom shall be appointed by the League of Cities and Towns, one from a |
| 10 | city and one from a town to represent the interests of municipalities that administer building code |
| 11 | <u>issues;</u> |
| 12 | (10) One of whom shall be the chairperson of the Rhode Island historical preservation |
| 13 | and heritage commission, or his or her designee; |
| 14 | (11) One of whom shall be the President of the Rhode Island builders' association or his |
| 15 | or her designee; |
| 16 | (12) One of whom shall be an environmental engineer, to be appointed by the governor; |
| 17 | <u>and</u> |
| 18 | (13) One of whom shall be an attorney whose practice is concentrated in building and |
| 19 | construction, to be appointed by the governor. |
| 20 | (b) Forthwith upon the effective date of this chapter, the members of the council shall |
| 21 | meet at the call of the chairs and organize. Vacancies in the council shall be filled in like manner |
| 22 | as the original appointment. |
| 23 | (c) The department of public safety is hereby directed to provide suitable quarters for the |
| 24 | council. |
| 25 | (d) All departments and agencies of the state shall furnish such advice and information |
| 26 | documentary and otherwise to the commission and its agents as is deemed necessary or desirable |
| 27 | by the commission to facilitate the purposes of this chapter. |
| 28 | 23-88-3. Meeting and reporting requirements. – The council shall meet regularly and |
| 29 | present and report its findings and recommendations to the senate housing and municipal |
| 30 | government committee by March 31, 2014. The council shall cease to exist on July 1, 2015. |
| 31 | SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. |
