RECOGNIZING SOCORRO GOMEZ-POTTER FOR HER OUTSTANDING LEADERSHIP IN PUBLIC EDUCATION

1 WHEREAS, Since taking the helm as Principal of the Reservoir Avenue Elementary 2 School eight years ago, Socorro Gomez-Potter has inspired her staff and the school's students to 3 envision their possibilities and to believe that they can build a future full of promise; and 4 WHEREAS, Socorro Gomez-Potter was born in Jalisco, Mexico. As a young child, she emigrated from her homeland and attended elementary school through post graduate studies in 5 the State of California while toiling as a migrant worker in the grape fields; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Credited with many admirable "firsts," Ms. Gomez-Potter was the first 8 Latina from her community to graduate from college and she was the first Mexican teacher hired 9 at her former elementary school; and 10 WHEREAS, In 1995, Ms. Gomez-Potter moved to Rhode Island and was hired as the 11 Assistant Principal at Roger Williams Middle School. In 1997, she became the Principal of Alfred 12 Lima School and seven years later, she was named Principal of the Reservoir Avenue Elementary 13 School, a position she has held for the past eight years; and 14 WHEREAS, During her tenure at the Reservoir Avenue Elementary School, Principal 15 Gomez-Potter has been a true and proven champion of education and she is a tremendous asset to 16 both the school and the community. She not only actively engages her students, but also their families by organizing and promoting school events, community involvement, and family 17 18 leadership; and

Progress reports and the school's students have distinguished themselves in myriad areas of the
NECAP. In addition, two years ago, Reservoir Avenue Elementary was one of two schools in the
