# AN ACT

#### RELATING TO STATE AFFAIRS AND GOVERNMENT

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

Title 42 of the General Laws entitled "STATE AFFAIRS AND 2 GOVERNMENT" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following chapter: 3 CHAPTER 155 4 RHODE ISLAND PERFORMANCE EXCELLENCE PROGRAM 5 42-155-1. Legislative findings. -- For decades, private industry has been utilizing continuous improvement tools in order to make their operations more efficient and effective. 6 7 These improvement tools have been a critical and important component for successfully 8 competing in the global economy. Unfortunately, the concept of continuous improvement has 9 largely been absent from governmental operations, however, during the past few years, 10 governors, and state departments and agencies across the country have begun implementing improvement tools in the workforce. As a result, inefficient governmental operating systems have 11 12 been streamlined, workforce effectiveness has been enhanced and improved customer service has 13 been provided to constituents. 14 Continuous improvement must become part of the governmental culture, and the program 15 established by this chapter is an attempt to encourage state leaders, and agency and departmental leaders to learn and utilize tools of process development and improvement in order to improve 16 17 and enhance governmental services for the residents of Rhode Island.
