#### RELATING TO EDUCATION - ADULT EDUCATION

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 16-63 of the General Laws entitled "Adult Education" is hereby
   amended by adding thereto the following sections:
- 3 <u>16-63-13.1. Legislative findings. The general assembly finds: (1) That close to eighty-</u>
- 4 four thousand (84,000) working age Rhode Islanders do not have a high school diploma or
- 5 <u>equivalent;</u>
- 6 (2) That increasing the number of Rhode Islanders who have a high school diploma or
  7 equivalent is vital to the state's economic competitiveness;
- 8 (3) That workers who have a high school diploma or equivalent earn almost seventy
- 9 percent (70%) more than those who do not have this credential; and

10 (4) That the cost of taking the high school equivalency test rose by over one hundred

11 percent (100%) from 2013 to 2014 and the state wishes to remove any financial barrier to taking

12 <u>the test.</u>

1 This act would authorize the department of education to waive any fees associated with 2 the high school equivalency test for individuals with limited income and appropriates the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) each year commencing July 1, 2014 to cover 3 4 administrative costs associated with this program. 5
