It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 RESOLVED, That the special legislative commission created by resolution No. 416
2 passed by the General Assembly at its January session, A.D. 2013, and approved July 17, 2013
3 entitled "Joint Resolution Creating a Special Legislative Commission To Study Rhode Island's
4 Zoning and Subdivision Enabling Acts" is hereby authorized to continue its study and make a
5 report to the General Assembly on or before January 15, 2015, and said commission shall expire
6 on June 15, 2015, and be it further

7 RESOLVED, That the time for reporting authorized by resolution No. 416 passed by the
8 General Assembly at its January session, A.D. 2013, and approved July 17, 2013, be and the same
9 is hereby rescinded; and be it further

10 RESOLVED, That the composition of said legislative commission is hereby amended by
11 changing the membership to nine (9) members; one of whom shall be a member of the House of
12 Representatives, to be appointed by the Speaker; one of whom shall be a member of the Senate,
13 to be appointed by the President of the Senate; one of whom shall be the President of the
14 Builders' Association, or designee; one of whom shall be the Executive Director of Grow Smart
15 Rhode Island, or designee; one of whom shall be the Executive Director of the League of Cities
16 and Towns, or designee; one of whom shall be the President of the Rhode Island Chapter of the
17 American Planning Association, or designee; one of whom shall be the Associate Director of the
18 Rhode Island Division of Planning, or designee; one of whom shall be a representative of the

- 1 Office of Regulatory Reform, to be appointed by the Governor; and one of whom shall be a
- 2 representative of the business industry, to be appointed by the Governor.
