Section 42-9-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 42-9 entitled "Department 7 of Attorney General" is hereby amended to read as follows: 8 42-9-4. Prosecution of offenses. -- (a) The attorney general shall draw and present all 9 informations and indictments, or other legal or equitable process, against any offenders, as by law 10 required, and diligently, by a due course of law or equity, prosecute them to final judgment and 11 execution. 12 (b) The duty of the attorney general under this section shall include the duty to prosecute all charges of violations of sections 31-27-2.1, 31-27-2.3, and/or 31-27-2.5, jurisdiction over the 13 14

adjudication of which is conferred upon the traffic tribunal under chapter 41.1 of title 31.

(c) The duty of the attorney general under this section shall include the duty to prosecute
