10	individuals and particularly for our state's senior citizens; and
11	WHEREAS, The practice of pharmacy and the role of the Pharmacist is constantly
12	evolving in order to meet the needs of patients struggling with an increasingly complicated and

14	WHEREAS, Rhode Island is fortunate to have the University of Rhode Island's College
