It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 22-7.4 of the General Laws entitled "Permanent Joint Committee
- 2 on Naming All New Buildings, Bridges, Edifices and Other State Constructions" is hereby
- 3 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 4 <u>22-7.4-124. The John J. Wrenn Building. --</u> <u>Building 71 located in the Pastore</u>
- 5 Complex in the city of Cranston, shall hereafter be named and known as "The John J. Wrenn
- 6 <u>Building" in honor of the former Speaker of the Rhode Island House of Representatives, John</u>
- Wrenn, who championed the people of this state for fair housing and employment laws; and in
- 8 recognition of his outstanding leadership and myriad contributions to the state of Rhode Island.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
