1 WHEREAS, The Tiverton/Rogers Co-op Lacrosse team finished the regular season with 2 a 12-1 record and tied for first place in the regular season league standings. They also compiled a 3 superb overall record of 13-2 and outscored their opponents in the regular season by more than one hundred points; and 4 5 WHEREAS, After overwhelming Scituate in the quarterfinals of the 2014 Rhode Island Boys' Division III Tournament by the score of 15-1, Tiverton/Rogers faced a dangerous 6 7 Burrillville/North Smithfield squad in the semi-finals. In a scintillating match that included numerous lead changes, Tiverton/Rogers emerged victorious after scoring two quick goals in a 8 9 row and holding Burrillville/North Smithfield scoreless for the last four minutes of the game; and WHEREAS, The 2014 Rhode Island Boys' Lacrosse Division III Championship game 10 11 was held at Brown University's Stevenson Field between the two squads that had tied for the 12 regular season league title, Tiverton/Rogers and Coventry High School.
