- 3 <u>23-24.11-3. Requirements. --</u> All children's jewelry manufactured sold one hundred
- 4 eighty (180) days after the effective date of this act shall meet the requirements of ASTM F 2923-
- 5 11.
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
