SECTION 1. Section 23-28.2-26 of the General Laws in Chapter 23-28.2 entitled

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

2	"Division of Fire Safety" is hereby amended to read as follows:
3	23-28.2-26. Plan review fees (a) Every request for plan review, by the state fire
4	marshal's office, under the provisions of the Fire Safety Code shall be accompanied by the fee
5	prescribed in this section. Plan review fees shall be as follows:
6	NEW BUILDING, ADDITIONS, ALTERATION, STRUCTURES, ETC. General permit
7	fees based on cost of construction
8	\$500 or less \$25.00
9	Over \$500 but not over \$1,000 \$35.00
10	Over \$1,000 but not over \$2,000 \$45.00
11	Over \$2,000 but not over \$500,000 \$45.00+
12	(plus \$6.00 per \$1,000 or fraction thereof over \$2,000)
13	Over \$500,000 \$3,033.00+
14	(plus \$4.00 per \$1,000 or fraction thereof over \$500,000)
15	(b) All fees collected pursuant to this section shall be deposited as general revenue
16	follows-:
17	(1) Fifteen percent (15%) of all plan review fees collected by the division of state fire
18	marshal shall be deposited in a restricted account managed by the division.
19	(2) These funds shall be used by the division of the state fire marshal for the following

1	purposes:
2	(i) To retain the services of licensed professional architects, engineers or consultants to
3	assist in the plan review process, if necessary as determined by the state fire marshal consistent
4	with the terms of § 23-28.1-6(a); and
5	(ii) To support the training and education requirements of the division of state marshal as
6	deemed necessary by the marshal in order to obtain and retain the requisite skills for staff
7	members required to perform the duties and services mandated by § 23-28.1-6.
8	(3) All remaining fund shall be deposited as general revenue.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
