- 4 policy advisory council which shall consist of three (3) seven (7) members: the director of health,
- or his or her designee; the director of environmental management, or his or her designee; and the 5
- director of administration, or his or her designee, the director of the department of human 6
- services, or his or her designee; the director of the division of elderly affairs, or his or her 7
- 8 designee; the director of the department of corrections, or his or her designee; and the
- 9 commissioner of elementary and secondary education, or his or her designee. The members of the
- 10 commission shall elect a chairperson from among themselves.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 11
