It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 11-5 of the General Laws entitled "Assaults" is hereby amended by
- 2 adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>11-5-17. Assault or battery for purpose of causing unconsciousness. Any person</u>
- 4 who shall make an assault or battery, or both, by causing, or attempting to cause, another person
- 5 to be rendered unconscious by a single punch, kick, or other singular striking motion to the head
- 6 of such person for the purpose of bringing about the loss of consciousness of such person, or who
- 7 shall knowingly assist, aid, abet, solicit, encourage, counsel, command, or conspire to coerce any
- 8 person to commit such an act, shall be deemed to have committed a felony and shall be
- 9 imprisoned for not more than three (3) years or fined not more than one thousand five hundred
- 10 <u>dollars (\$1,500), or both.</u>
- 11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
