It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16-21 of the General Laws entitled "Health and Safety of Pupils" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>16-21-35. Child imagination and play protection act. (a) The legislature hereby finds</u>
- 4 <u>and declares as follows:</u>
- 5 (1) That a healthy imagination and play are crucial to a child's proper social and mental
- 6 development, and such play should not be unnecessarily stifled or discouraged;
- 7 (2) That various toys are readily available which may resemble firearms, but cannot be
- 8 mistaken for an actual firearm by any reasonable person exercising reasonable judgment; and
- 9 (3) That the imagination of children may prompt them to create their own toys out of
- 10 <u>common everyday objects, and said toys may also resemble a firearm, but cannot be mistaken for</u>
- 11 <u>an actual firearm by any reasonable person exercising reasonable judgment.</u>
- 12 (b) It shall be unlawful for any school administrator or government official to invoke or
- 13 impose any disciplinary action against any child solely for possession or engaging in imaginary
- 14 play with any such toy which may resemble a firearm but cannot be mistaken for an actual
- 15 <u>firearm by any reasonable person exercising reasonable judgment.</u>
- 16 (c) The burden of proof that such a toy could be mistaken for an actual firearm shall be
- 17 <u>on the school administrator or other government official.</u>

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

- 2 unless a reasonable person could mistake the toy for a real gun.
- 3 This act would take effect upon passage.
