It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 39-18 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Public Transit
- 2 Authority" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following sections:
- 3 39-18-25. Limitations of damages. In any tort action against the authority, its
- 4 members and/or its employees acting in their official capacity, any damages recovered therein
- 5 <u>shall not exceed the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).</u>
- 6 <u>39-18-26. Damages in excess of limitation.</u> <u>The general assembly may, by special act,</u>
- 7 <u>authorize actions of tort against the authority, its members and/or its employees acting in their</u>
- 8 official capacity, in particular cases in which the amount of damages to be recovered may exceed
- 9 one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and shall apply to actions filed on or
- after the date of passage of this act.

1	This act would establish a limitation of damages of \$100,000 in any tort action filed
2	against the Rhode Island Public Transit Authority. This act would permit the general assembly to
3	authorize damages in tort actions in excess of \$100,000 by special act.
4	This act would take effect on passage and would apply to actions filed on or after the date
5	of passage of this act.
