It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 31-1-18 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-1 entitled "Definitions
- 2 and General Code Provisions" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- <u>3</u> <u>31-1-18. Resident and nonresident. --</u> (a) "Nonresident" means any person who is not a
 resident of this state or is temporarily residing in this state as a student or as a member of the
 armed forces of the United States.
- 6 (b) "Resident" means a person:
- 7 (1) Who owns, rents, or leases real estate within the state as his or her residence and:
- 8 Whose legal residence is the state of Rhode Island, and:
- 9 (i) Engages in a trade, business, or profession in this state; or Who engages in intrastate
- 10 <u>business and operates in such a business any motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer, or any person</u>
- 11 maintaining such vehicles in this state, as the home state of such vehicles; or
- 12 (ii) Who physically resides in this state and engages in a trade, profession, occupation, or
- 13 accepts gainful employment in this state; or
- (ii) (iii) Enrolls his or her children in a school in this state for a period exceeding ninety
 (90) days; or
- 16 (2) Who is registered to vote or is eligible to register to vote under the laws of this state.
- 17 Who declares that he or she is a resident of this state to obtain privileges not ordinarily extended
- 18 to nonresidents of this state.
- 19 (3) The term does not include a person who is an actual tourist, an out-of-state student, a

- 1 <u>foreign exchange student, or a seasonal resident.</u>
- 2 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1 This act would make changes to the definition of the term "resident" for purposes of the 2 motor vehicle code and includes those who do business in the state or intrastate or declares Rhode 3 Island his or her residence.
